mediate	to act as negotiator between opposing sides in a dispute.
mediocrity	the condition of being commonplace or ordinary, somewhere in the middle between high and low; a very ordinary person.
medium	1. a substance or element through which something is transmitted. 2. a person thought to have communication with spirits of the dead.
non sequitur	a statement that does not follow logically from evidence.
obsequious	excessively willing to yield to others.
subsequent	coming after or later.
sequester	1. to go into hiding; to seek solitude. 2. to isolate.

execute	to carry out or put into effect (a plan, order, or course of action).
persecute	to subject (someone) to hostility and ill-treatment, especially because of their race or political or religious beliefs.
prosecute	to institute legal proceedings against (a person or organization).
pursue	to follow (someone or something) in order to catch or attack them.
sect	a group of people with somewhat different religious beliefs (typically regarded as heretical) from those of a larger group to which they belong.
sequel	a published, broadcast, or recorded work that continues the story or develops the theme of an earlier one.
sue	to institute legal proceedings against (a person or institution), typically for redress.
suitor	a man who pursues a relationship with a particular woman, with a view to marriage.
ensue	to happen or occur afterward or as a result.
inconsequential	not important or significant.
